## Pratical information for coach drivers

A drop-off zone is available down the "Puits l'Eau" street (heading to the Grand-Place). GPS :  $50^{\circ}36' \ 26.06'' \ N / 3^{\circ} \ 23' \ 29.19''E$ . The tourist office is located less than 200m across the pedestrian zone.



Free long-term parking areas are also available at the Esplanade du Conseil de l'Europe (P2) and next to the Sports Hall (P1). GPS : 50°36' 15.52" N / 3° 22' 52.67" E
